Mr. Pool amassed a financial fortune as founder and long-time chief executive of Air Products and Chemicals, Inc. He directed that the Trust be named as a memorial for his first wife, Dorothy Rider Pool, who died of cancer in 1967. The mission of The Dorothy Rider Pool Health Care Trust is to serve as a resource that enables Lehigh Valley Hospital to be a superior regional hospital and improve the health of the citizens of the region it serves.

The Trust operates as a public charitable trust. Led by a small and dedicated staff, the Trust, with the assistance of local, regional and national advisors, addresses the needs of the citizens of the Lehigh Valley and supports programs to meet those needs.
